

Cincinnati experienced the first drop in PMI since June 2015, down to 51.5 in October from 52.0 in September. The national PMI continued to stagnate at 50.1, down from 50.2 in September. Locally, New Imports and Production figures continue to outpace the nation. However, local Inventories, Perceived Customer Inventory Levels, and Commodity Prices have continued contraction.
