The Forum Program

We will be charging \$25 for the meal. This is comparable to other affiliates of our size.

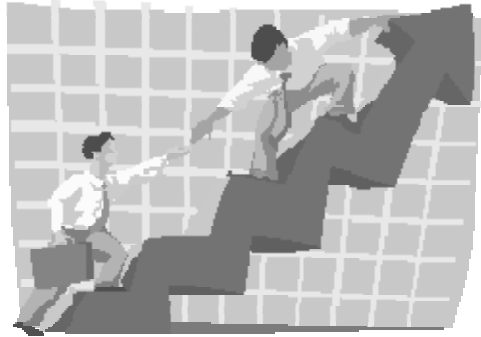
