The Dinner Program

The title for the dinner presentation is “What’s the Use of Purchasing”. You will learn that if four key components are in place – procurement automation, spend analysis, sourcing, and contracting – then procurement’s contribution to the organization will be maximized. Jeff Pinkerton will explain how this ties together the tactical aspects of procurement, from requisitioning, approvals, budgets and ordering, to the understanding of spend patterns, via analytics, to the strategic aspects of sourcing and contracting.

Speaker Backgrounds

Ty Gettis currently serves as Vice President of the Kentuckian Minority Business Council. He has held this position since November of 2003. Ty is a native of Mississippi but now makes Kentucky his home. Jeff Pinkerton is Director of product Strategy for the ePlus, inc. Corporation. He is responsible for product direction, managing “the Spend+ analytics product” and marketing and sales support. Prior to this position, Jeff was Chief Product Strategist for Purchasesoft, Inc. He also was Director of corporate purchasing with a \$6 billion expenditure across 150 manufacturing sites.
