In 1860 there were 36 breweries in Cincinnati, 26 shortly before Prohibition. Cincinnatians took their beer drinking seriously. Whether they carried it home in "growlers" or drank it at the neighborhood saloon, on the average every Cincinnatiian consumed 40 gallons a year - 24 more than the national average.

Jim Bruckmann of the Bruckmann Brewery family will present a visual tour of Cincinnati's "golden age of breweries."

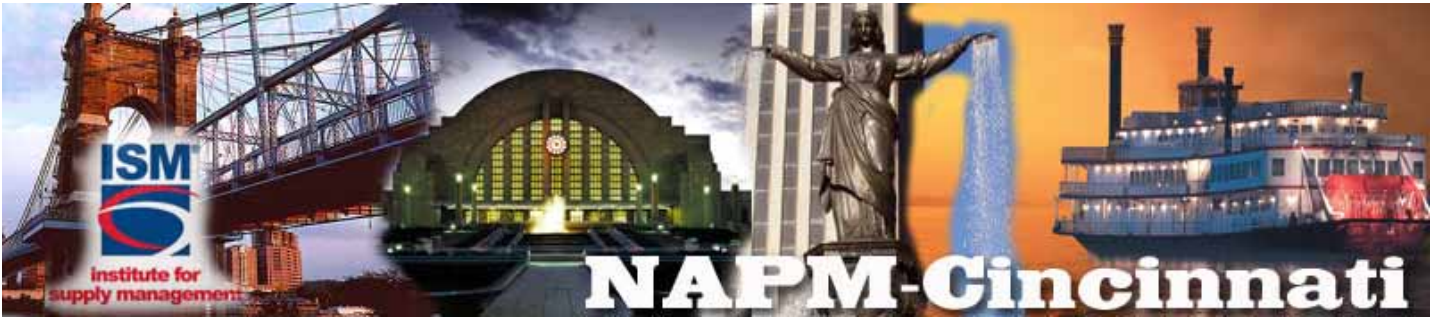
Bruckmann's family operated J.C. Bruckmann Brewery in South Cumminsville from 1891 to the 1950s. The company survived Prohibition by producing "Bruck's Near Beer" during the 20s and 30s. But Bruckmann's specialty was bock and dark beers.

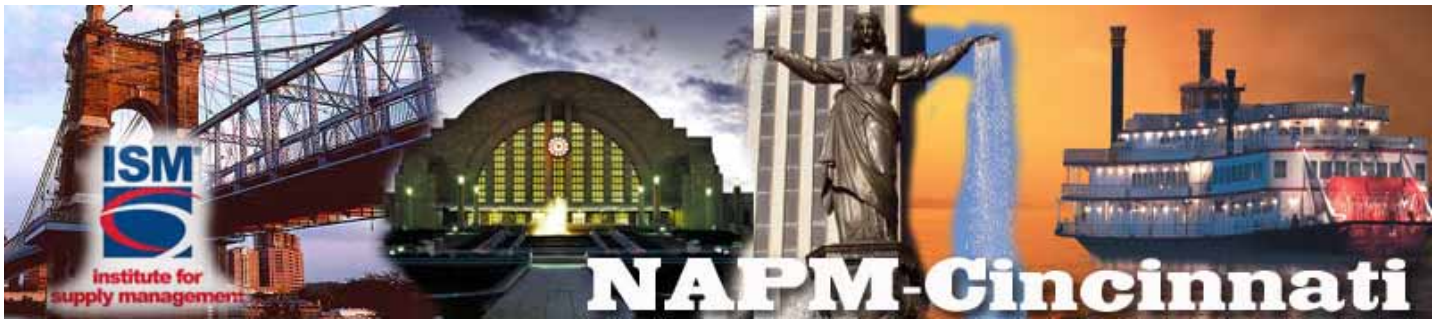

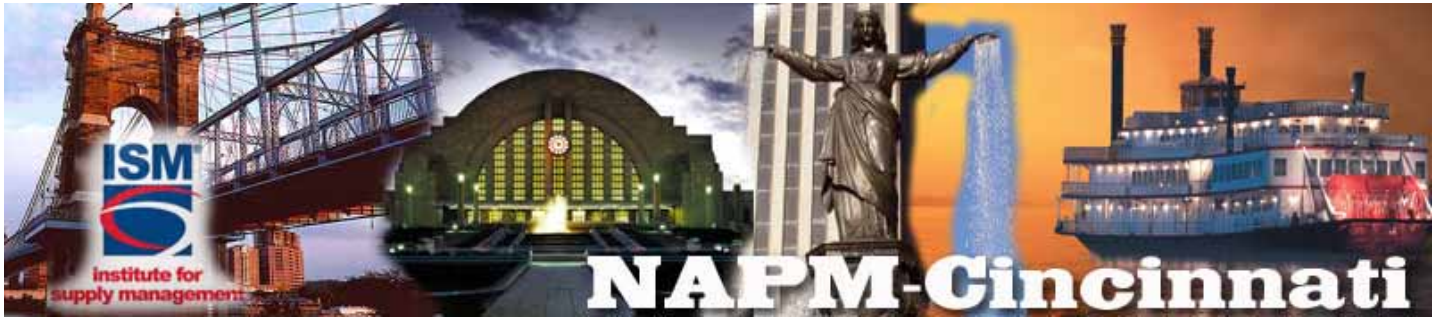
