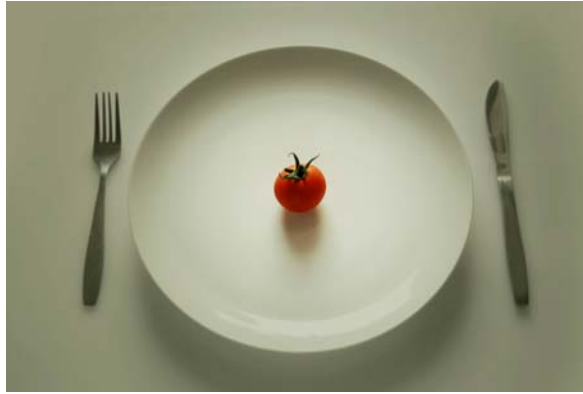

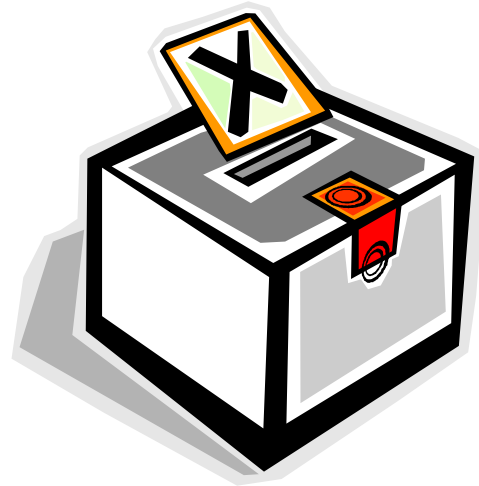

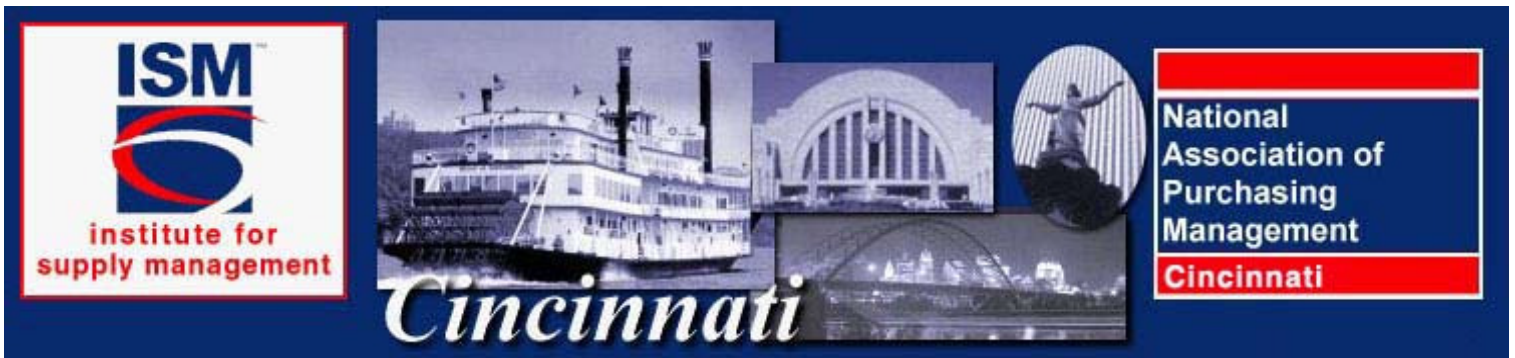
Vice President – vote for one:

AARON PARIS

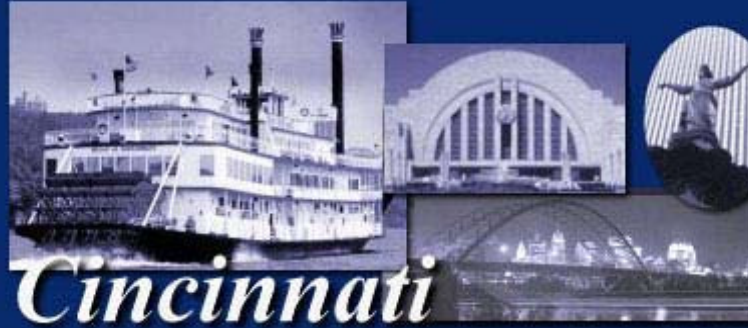
